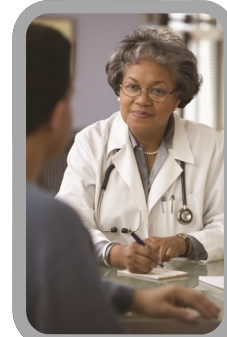

- ◇ Proof of identity (driver's license, employment ID, etc.)
- ◇ Proof of Montgomery County residence (lease, utility bill, etc.)
- ◇ Call in advance to find out if you need to bring anything else

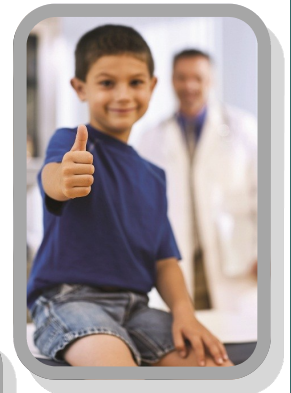

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About Montgomery Cares

A network of clinics at multiple sites throughout Montgomery County that provide primary and specialty care to low-income, uninsured County residents age 18+.

Services:

- ◇ Medical check-ups
- ◇ Medicine
- ◇ Lab tests
- ◇ Cancer screenings
- ◇ Access to specialists

You may be eligible if:

- ◇ You live in Montgomery County
- ◇ You are 18 or older
- ◇ You do not have any health insurance (includes: Qualified Health Plan, State or Federal insurance programs such as Medicaid or Medicare)
- ◇ Your income is at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level

HOW TO APPLY?

Call the **Montgomery Cares** clinic closest to you to make an appointment.
Ask the clinic about the information and documents to bring.

About Care For Kids

Provides affordable primary and specialty care to the children of low-income families in Montgomery County who are not enrolled in other state or federal health insurance programs.

Services:

- ◇ Well child visits
- ◇ Medical check-ups
- ◇ Dental care
- ◇ Vision care
- ◇ Medicine
- ◇ Access to specialists
- ◇ And more...

Your child may be eligible if:

- ◇ They are below the age of 18
- ◇ They are not enrolled in any State or Federal insurance programs including Maryland Children's Health Insurance program
- ◇ Your family lives in Montgomery County
- ◇ Your family's income is at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level

HOW TO APPLY?

Care for Kids: Contact the Montgomery County **Office of Eligibility and Support Services (OESS)**.

About Montgomery Perinatal Program

Provides home visiting services for all low-income pregnant women living in Montgomery County. The program helps pregnant women who are uninsured.

All participants receive Nurse or Community Health Worker Home Visiting and Case Management services including but not limited to:

- ◇ Referrals
- ◇ Linkages to health care
- ◇ Support, education
- ◇ Needed services and resources to ensure a safe and healthy pregnancy, delivery, postpartum, and newborn

You may be eligible if you are:

- ◇ Pregnant
- ◇ Low-income, at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level
- ◇ You live in Montgomery County
